POLICE/FIRE DEPARTMENT HOLD HARMLESS

The **owner of the premises** for which this permit is issued, by his acceptance thereof, agrees for himself, his lessees, agents, heirs, successors and assigns that for so long as an automatic protection system is installed on the premises he shall hold the Town of Duck harmless and the Town of Duck, its agents and employees shall not be liable for any damage to the premises caused by the entry of any member of the Duck Police Department or the Duck Volunteer Fire Department or its members in response to an alarm initiated by the automatic protection system.

PERMIT FEES

The adopted fee schedule for the Town of Duck establishes the following fees for permits:

<u>INITIAL APPLICATION FEE</u>	\$50.00
<u>ANNUAL RENEWAL FEE</u>	\$ 0.00
<u>REINSTATEMENT FEE</u>	\$50.00
<u>APS that does not transmit a signal offsite</u>	No Charge (but permit is required)

All permits are valid for **one (1) year** from the date of issue. Renewal notices are mailed to permit holders prior to the permit expiration date.

EXCESSIVE FALSE ALARM FEES

The adopted fee schedule for the Town of Duck establishes the following fees for excessive false alarms:

False Alarm Fees (In any 30-day period)

First, Second, Third No charge

Fourth \$150.00

Fifth Permit Revoked, all fees to date and reinstatement fee of \$200.00 are to be submitted to the Town of Duck.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Alarm sites with local alarm systems (non-monitored) are required to have a valid alarm system permit.

It is the responsibility of the permit holder to provide the permit number to their alarm and/or monitoring company.
